## PROFILE

Hanne was invited to join 2 Hare Court on the successful completion of her pupillage. She defends and prosecutes and has been instructed both alone and as a junior in a wide range of serious criminal matters.

Hanne is instructed by several of the prosecution agencies, such as the Crown Prosecution Service, HM Revenue Customs and Excise and the Probation Service. Equally she acts for a variety of defence solicitors. She has also appeared before the Courts Martial.

As a led junior she has appeared in a number of high profile cases, for example recently in *R v Gunn*, a multi-handed drugs conspiracy in the Midlands, representing the main defendant. Her trial practice without a leader encompasses wounding/GBH with intent, sexual offences, money laundering, firearms offences, robbery, kidnap, perverting the course of justice and Class A drug supply.

Hanne's other legal experience includes a 3 month internship with a human rights group in Jamaica who represent death row inmates, 4 months as a researcher in Privy Council appellate work for the City firm, Simmons Muirhead & Burton, and 6 months court clerking for a criminal defence solicitors.

Hanne is an active member of the Young Bar Committee.

Appearance:	Defence Junior
Category:	General Crime
Description:	James King was charged with Amy Winehouse's husband of conspiring to pervert the course of justice.

Case name: *DPP v Broom*  
Appearance: Respondent  
Category: Appeal by way of case stated from the Magistrates' Court to the High Court, Queen's Bench Division.  
Description: A novel point of law was explored on the powers of arrest and search of suspects by police officers

Case Name: *R v Morgan*  
Appearance: Defence Junior  
Category: Armed robbery conspiracy  
Description: A multi-handed conspiracy of armed robberies of a number of travel agents throughout the south of England. Represented the main defendant.

Case Name: *R v Barrington*  
Appearance: Prosecution  
Category: Wounding/GBH with intent.  
Description: Girl 'glassed' the eyeball of another in a fight in a nightclub, impairing the complainant's vision.

Case Name: *R v Gunn*  
Appearance: Defence Junior  
Category: Conspiracy to supply Class A and B drugs  
Description: A high profile, multi-handed drugs conspiracy in the Midlands; represented main defendant who is part of a notorious drugs family. Attracted significant media attention.

Case Name: *R v Afonso*  
Appearance: Defence  
Category: Possession of a firearm  
Description: Man charged with possessing an imitation firearm to cause harassment, alarm or distress to his young daughter and son.

Case Name: *R v Mazilu*  
Appearance: Defence Junior  
Category: Human trafficking  
Description: Romanian woman charged with rape and controlling the prostitution of other Romanian women. This case is now proceeding to the Court of Appeal.

Case Name: *R v Ahmed*  
Appearance: Defence  
Category: Wounding/GBH with intent.  
Description: Iraqi national initially charged with attempted murder after a serious stabbing incident involving another Iraqi national.

Case Name: *R v Pollard*  
Appearance: Defence Junior  
Category: Drugs Conspiracy  
Description: A ten-handed conspiracy to supply Class A drugs.

Case Name: *R v Gaffar and Others*  
Appearance: Prosecution  
Category: Fraud  
Detail: Junior in a seven handed Customs and Excise prosecution

Case Name: *R v Ogunobo*  
Appearance: Defence  
Category: Murder  
Detail: Junior in high profile youth murder trial at the Central Criminal Court with Martin Heslop QC and Brendan Kelly.
