Detail: Road rage trial. Conviction quashed in Court of Appeal owing to prosecution refusal to disclose details of 999 callers.

Case Name: *R v Miah and Hussain*

Category: Conspiracy to commit GBH
Detail: High profile trial concerning gang warfare in Euston. One of first cases where ASBO imposed.

Case Name: *R v Kindoki and others*
Appearance: Prosecution
Category: Racially Aggravated ABH
Detail: Multi-handed racially aggravated knife attack arising out of neighbour dispute.

Case Name: *R v Nichole Rice and others*
Appearance: Defence
Category: Conspiracy to kidnap and falsely imprison
Detail: Multi-handed trial involving allegations of kidnap, torture and large scale drug importation based on cell site analysis evidence.

Case Name: *R v Parviez and Mehmood*
Appearance: Prosecution
Category: Arson + Witness intimidation + Escape from lawful custody
Detail: Case arising out of family feud. First defendant escaped from dock during hearing.

Case Name: *R v Jay Murray*
Appearance: Defence
Category: Rape
Detail: High profile case concerning postman who pleaded guilty to raping customer, after forcibly entering her home. Two day sentencing hearing involving examination of witnesses resulted in ruling that defendant did not constitute a public danger under CJA 2003 provisions.

Case Name: *R v Marie Ashby and another*
Appearance: Defence
Category: Rape and Wilful cruelty to children
Detail: Defendant charged with aiding and abetting her husband to rape children from her previous marriage.

Case Name: *R v Sean Mannion*
Appearance: Prosecution
Category: Engaging in sexual activity in the presence of a child
Detail: Sensitive case involving indecency towards young boy at church.

Case Name: *R v Manuel Jeronimo*
Appearance: Defence
Category: Money laundering + Passport forgeries + Cheque offences
Detail: 22 count indictment involving series of complex frauds.

Case Name: *R v Carlos Ambrosio*
Appearance: Defence
Category: Fraud and Deception
Detail: Part of substantial conspiracy relating to pension books.
