Business Crime & Financial Services

Gavin advises corporates, as external counsel:

- on the impact of the money laundering regulations – recent instructions relate to: estate agents; intellectual property portfolios; and, those wishing to establish interests in lawful cannabis businesses
- on breaches of financial sanctions and breaches of the export licensing regime – recent instructions relate to: dual-use goods and services in the manufacturing sector, where end-user concerns and WMD proliferation risks have been identified; and, the sale of cryptographic software to designated jurisdictions

Gavin also undertakes restraint and asset freezing work. He acted for Raymond May in the seminal House of Lords case on the definition of ‘obtaining’ benefit. He has a wealth of experience in applying for injunctions on behalf of prosecuting authorities and in resisting them on behalf of individuals and other legal entities. Gavin advises and represents individuals in enforcement proceedings and has recently assisted the proprietor of the London Fields Brewery in proceedings before the Westminster Magistrates’ Court

In the recent past, Gavin has:

- represented a globally recognised principal researcher in space technology for alleged involvement in a fraud on an academic institution
- advised on criminal and professional conduct issues in a high profile property dispute in the High Court
- advised an individual in relation to an SFO investigation into alleged corruption between UK companies and Indonesian state actors
- represented a company in the first proceedings brought by the Pensions Regulator for failure to implement the Workplace Pension

- appeared in the Family Division for a BVI company whose assets were frozen pursuant to ancillary relief proceedings after a ‘big-money’ divorce. Since then, he has assisted a number of litigants in matrimonial finance proceedings

Criminal Defence

Gavin has appeared for the defence in numerous homicide cases before the Central Criminal Court. In recent years he has represented individuals charged with rape (disclosure of multi-agency records and the controversial statistical analysis of DNA), causing non-accidental harm to children (numerous paediatric, medical experts), arson

and firearms offences (expert DNA and cell-site evidence) and substantial drug trafficking (covert probe intercept evidence and evidence obtained under letters of request).

Gavin is currently representing:

- the alleged lead conspirator in proceedings for drug trafficking – involving organised crime groups in the Greater Manchester area
- an individual charged with murder – arising from escalating domestic tensions and controlling behaviour during lock-down
- an individual charged with conspiracy to counterfeit currency – the most significant case of its kind for more than a decade, involving >£5million of £20 notes

In the recent past, Gavin has represented:

- a Zimbabwean national charged with the gross negligence manslaughter of the elderly woman for whom she was caring, in her home
- a UK national charged with murder in the course of an aggravated burglary
- a Chinese national in proceedings for money laundering involving the misuse of the Daigou 'luxury items' trading system
- a Nigerian national for conspiracy to commit fraud by false representation and conspiracy to launder the proceeds of crime, involving a multinational network of persons and organisations who transferred the proceeds through bank accounts in China
- the principal defendant in confiscation proceedings arising from the defendant's conviction for what the SFO dubbed "*the largest boiler room fraud ever pursued by a UK authority*" – valued at £70 million

In addition, Gavin has acted as leading counsel for the prosecution in perhaps the most significant proceedings ever brought by a Local Authority under the CPUT Regulations 2008 – for cold-calling the elderly and vulnerable and offering them 'free' alarm, fire and security systems.

Extradition

Having acted for various requesting states, eg. the USA in Welsh and Thrasher and the Russian Federation in Temerko (not to mention numerous European judicial authorities) Gavin's extradition practice has focused on defending individuals charged with, or convicted of, serious offences including murder, terrorism and fraud.

Gavin has recently:

- prevented the extradition to Germany of a UK national for tax evasion offences
- prevented the extradition to the Czech Republic of a businessman charged with offences arising from a lost weekend in Prague
- prevented the extradition to Romania of an individual whose conviction was obtained on inadmissible communications covertly intercepted by the Romanian Intelligence Services
- prevented the extradition to UAE of the director of an aviation business

In addition, Gavin acted in the first ever extraditions to Peru (a series of accusation cases involving significant drug trafficking) and in extradition proceedings brought by Spain for the largest shipment of cocaine ever to be intercepted in European waters.

Inquests & Public Inquiries

Gavin's advice and advocacy is regularly sought in relation to Coroner's Inquests. He has represented doctors and healthcare organisations in sensitive Inquests where: individuals are at risk of a finding of neglect or being required to 'self-report' to the GMC and NHS; and, where the prospect of criminal proceedings is an important factor in tactical decision-making.

In particular, recent cases have involved:

- representing a GP at an Inquest involving the death of a young woman after a long battle with *anorexia nervosa* [here](#)
- representing a GP Practice at an Inquest involving the death of a two year old boy who choked on a sausage while holidaying at Butlins [here](#)
- representing an Emergency Medicine Registrar at an Inquest involving a 'death in custody' where excessive police restraint contributed to death [here](#)
- representing an Emergency Medicine Registrar at an Inquest where a patient died as a result of *necrotising fasciitis* [here](#) and [here](#)

Professional Discipline

Gavin has represented individuals in conduct proceedings brought by the General Medical Council, the General Dental Council, the Nursing and Midwifery Council, the Solicitors Regulation Authority, the Council of the Inns of Court and the Council for Licensed Conveyancers. He has particular experience where different regulators each claim an overlapping jurisdiction and where the prospect of criminal proceedings is an important factor in tactical decision-making.

In particular, recent cases have involved:

- representing the National Health Service in the First-Tier Tribunal, in an appeal against a finding of 'inefficiency' and removal from the Performers List
- representing two students before a university conduct committee in relation to allegations of serious sexual misconduct
- representing doctors and dentists in conduct proceedings relating to: the handling and retention of patient confidential records; allegations of sexual assault; and, unchaperoned medical examinations of vulnerable individuals
- representing a licensed conveyancer in linked proceedings before the CLC, the SRA and Guildford Magistrates' Court
- representing nurses before the Nursing and Midwifery Council for: causing serious injury to a patient in her own home; and, failing to provide adequate care and failing properly to keep records in Police Custody Suites
- acting as legal assessor to the National Registers of Communication Professionals, in conduct proceedings relating to sign-language professionals
- presenting for the General Dental Council in conduct proceedings arising from a patient inadvertently drinking bleach during treatment
